



## Facts about Storvretaskolan in Uppsala



Storvretaskolan is a compulsory school built in the early 1950s. There are 430 pupils in the ages of 6-12. We have 18 classes, 3 in each grade, from preschool class until grade 5. In the afternoon the leisure time center takes care of 250 of the students with staff from the school. They are divided in four different groups depending on age. Lunch and a snack break are included during the school day. No payment for parents. The school cannot charge parents for money for excursions or going to museums. The school must provide all that by itself.

The curriculum provides both school and the leisure time center.

School teachers work together with special needs teachers, teacher assistants, student assistants and staff from leisure time center. Approximately 4 teachers work with special needs to students at Storvretaskolan. Swedish language, Maths and adjustments to provide help in the regular classroom are common work for the teachers in special needs. Students who have dyslexia are able to work with a computer in the classroom with their tasks.
