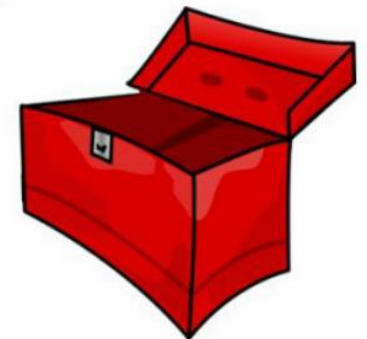

Why Inclusion?

Within all countries in Europe there is a recognition that inclusive education – or as termed in the Charter of Luxembourg – “**A school for all**” - provides an important foundation for ensuring equality of opportunity in all aspects of life



Development towards inclusion is a common European theme in education.

To be successful, the mental shift that it Requires has to develop beyond the ideals of policymakers and administrators, to accompany the daily practice of teachers and other stakeholders in education.

Inclusive education requires flexible education systems that are responsive to the diverse and often complex needs and needs to be adapted to the local context
