- classrooms

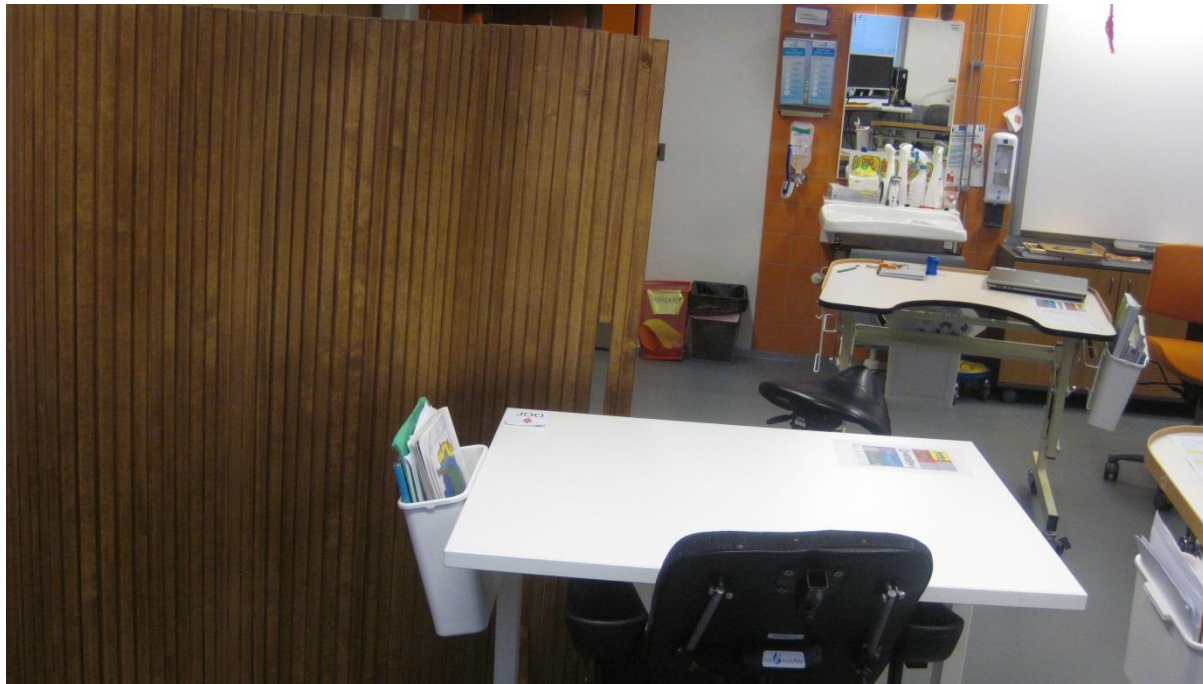
School building
