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### PUPILS CREATING EXERCISES FOR OTHER PUPILS

As a language teacher, I try to plan my lessons in such a way that my pupils get involved as much as possible. Before the tests, for revision and consolidation, sometimes even just for motivation, I have the pupils create their own puzzles, wordsearch puzzles, "tests" and even interactive exercises. They enjoy creating the tasks and doing the exercises their classmates have created. I needn't say, that I check everything before "testing" can start.

There are four question types and one, two or both languages to choose. The test changes just by ticking the little squares before the options. The test varies depending on the options chosen.





If the words are not typed in time, they can be typed into a small space that appears on the screen:




Then the race continues. Even the fastest pupils have difficulties in winning the race.







### THE 'OLD-FASHIONED' WAY

There is one more activity that we do before writing the tests. I have groups of 3-4 pupils create their own tests, this time the old way, meaning 'pen to paper'. They can use the coursebook and the workbook and create, according to my instructions, a test for another group. Groups swop the tests, do the tests, swop them again and mark them. Normally, they are very motivated, especially when marking the other group's test.


It is a great opportunity to learn how to to be critical, to learn from mistakes and to revise the topics for the real test, without even noticing.

Here are some examples created by grade 9 pupils:














With such a variety of possibilities, it is not difficult to find the right type of activity for the right pupil, in other words, to find something for everyone.
