## METHODS: HOW DO YOU ADJUST THE EDUCATION TO DIFFERENT LEVELS AMONG THE CHILDREN:

1. Internal differciation

School work is organized in such a way that every student can reach them objectives and standards according to the curriculum, regardless of his/her abilities.

2. Fleksible differenciation

One quarter of the lessons of a certain subject can be organized in groups of:

According to the level of knowledge (level 1 – consolidation of knowledge in order to reach minimal standards, level 2 - consolidation of knowledge in order to reach basic standards, level 3 – the pupils can reach the highest standards according the curriculum).

If the standards are reached, the pupils can change the group.

The groups are formed for the subject Slovenian, English and Maths. The groups are heterogenous, they are not devided by gender, nationality, religion, social environment or grades.

3. Heterogenous groups are formed in grade 8 and 9 in the following subject:

Slovenian, English and Maths.

This is done according to the advice and suggestions of the school counclors and in agreement with the school professional teams.
