

## METHODS: HOW DO YOU ADJUST THE EDUCATION TO DIFFERENT LEVELS AMONG THE CHILDREN:

### 1. Internal differentiation

School work is organized in such a way that every student can reach their objectives and standards according to the curriculum, regardless of his/her abilities.

### 2. Flexible differentiation

One quarter of the lessons of a certain subject can be organized in groups of:

According to the level of knowledge (level 1 – consolidation of knowledge in order to reach minimal standards, level 2 - consolidation of knowledge in order to reach basic standards, level 3 – the pupils can reach the highest standards according to the curriculum).

If the standards are reached, the pupils can change the group.

The groups are formed for the subjects Slovenian, English and Maths. The groups are heterogeneous, they are not divided by gender, nationality, religion, social environment or grades.

### 3. Heterogeneous groups are formed in grade 8 and 9 in the following subject:

Slovenian, English and Maths.

This is done according to the advice and suggestions of the school councilors and in agreement with the school professional teams.
