Description teacher training

- Level (degree):
 - University-Led
 - School centred initial teacher training
- # of years:
1 year plus your induction period (NQT-1 year)
- Additional programs:
Teach first, Armed forces, Academics



Specific conditions

- Requirements:

Graduates can apply directly whereas a PGCE needs C-Grades or standard equivalents in english, maths and a science subject

- Entry- exam:

Pass a numeracy and literacy skills test (free of charge)

- Pre-interview:

Possible but not necessary



Most important end competencies

Primary-

Designs teaching materials, plans and prepares lessons, develops assessment and support material, assesses work, organises extra curricular activities

Secondary-

Plans and presents lessons, develops assessment and support material, assesses work, organises extra curricular activities, gains the trust and respect of pupils, enables students to enjoy studying and achieving good results, teamwork within the department, pressure to meet deadlines, constant change in curriculum syllabi

SEN-

Sets up group coordinates, manages multi disciplinary teams, teaches children, keeps records, liaises with parents, school and educational services, often one to one teaching situations

TEFL (teaching english as a foreign language)-

Prepares and teaches lessons for non native english speakers, devises classroom exercises and obtains materials, marks homework/exams, writes reports, organises social activities, listens for correct pronunciation, flexibility required to strike up a rapport with all kinds of people
