
























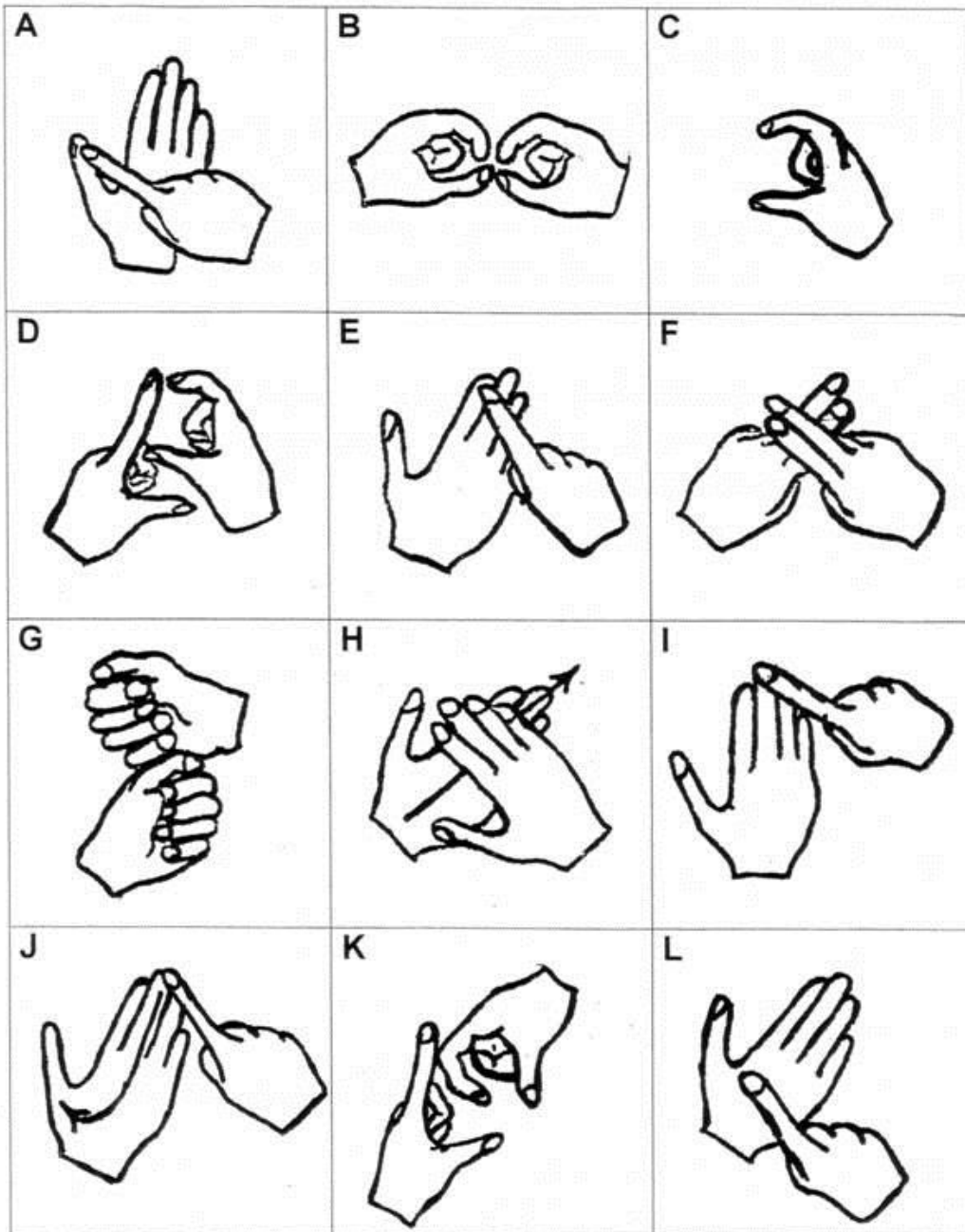


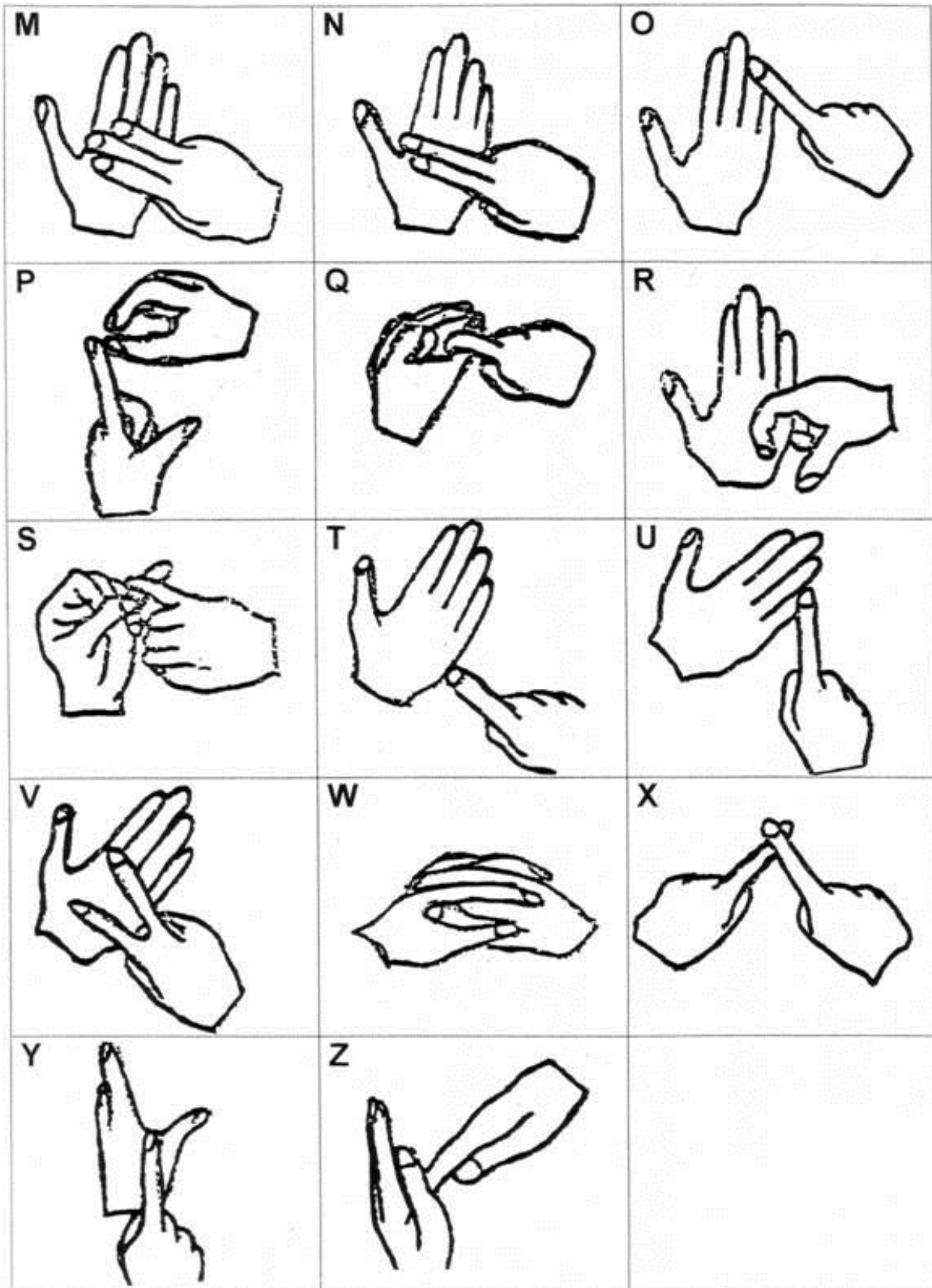


## MAKATON
